RULES AND CONDITIONS

- Membership subscription fees will be fixed by the Proprietor each year and must be paid annually in advance, on or before 1st April. A pro-rata annual fee, rounded up to the nearest whole month, will apply for those joining during a subscription year. All fees are non-refundable in the event of cancellation of membership, save that joining fees will be refunded should an application for membership be unsuccessful.
- Absolute discretion is granted to the Proprietor to reject any application for membership, or renewal, without ascribing any reason for so doing. The Proprietor may also refuse or withdraw admission to the Golf Centre and cancel any membership forthwith should any person, in his opinion, fail to abide by the Golf Centre Rules as issued from time to time.
- Membership numbers are limited. Upon payment of a membership fee, all members will be provided with a membership card which will remain the property of the Proprietor. Such cards must be carried at the Golf Centre at all times and must be produced to Golf Centre staff upon request. Cards are not transferable and their loss should be reported immediately to the Golf Centre reception.
- A member is entitled to use the facilities of the Golf Centre only in accordance with the Rules of the Centre applicable from time to time, and provided always that the Proprietor may in his sole discretion at any time withdraw any part of the facilities for any period of time.
- Members and visitors are asked to wear a form of dress appropriate to the time of day and place, on all occasions.
- The Proprietor will not in any way be responsible for any harm which may occur to any user of the Golf Centre as a result of their undertaking within the Golf Centre any physical activity which is beyond their physical capability.
- The Proprietor's liability for damage or loss to property belonging to users of the Golf Centre is strictly limited to damage or loss suffered as a result of the negligence of the Golf Centre or its staff. The Proprietor will not accept liability for the safety or security of personal property brought into the Golf Centre. All property left in the Golf Centre, or in cars parked in the Golf Centre car park, is left entirely at the owners' own risk.
- The Proprietor shall not accept liability for any personal injury to any user of the Golf Centre, other than liability due to the negligence of the Golf Centre or its staff. Any member who suffers an incident on the premises must report it immediately to the Golf Centre management.
- No animals will be permitted at the Golf Centre, with the exception of guide dogs.
- Entry to the Golf Centre is permitted only via the marked entrances. Fire exits are present in the interests of public safety and users of the Golf Centre must not interfere with these for any reason.
- All lost property must be handed in to the Golf Centre reception and will be disposed of after one month, unless claimed.

MEMBER DISCOUNT CARDS

1. Member Discount cards are valid for the same period as the associated membership subscription (1 April to 31 March) – please ensure you have renewed your membership prior to the end of the membership year to ensure your discounts continue from 1st April
2. Member Discount cards are issued to all Adult membership subscriptions
3. The Member Discount card will remain the property of the Proprietor. The card has a magnetic strip which uniquely identifies the member and will provide discounts according to their membership status – as the cards have a magnetic strip they should be kept carefully so as to protect them
4. Member Discount cards are not transferable and the member will be identified by the Charcombes Lounge till system via their name and photo. Misuse of the card will result in the card and discounts for that member being withdrawn
5. It is the responsibility of the Member to provide their Member Discount card to the staff member prior to placing an order so as to obtain discount on a sale. Discount cannot be given to members unless they present their Member Discount card – the Charcombes Lounge till system will only accept the magnetic cards in order to trigger discount levels
6. Member Discount cards will permit members to discount on drinks and food within Charcombes Lounge. The cards currently provide the following levels of discount:

7. Drink discount is given on all alcoholic drinks (beers, wines and spirits), soft drinks (draft and bottled) and hot drinks (tea / coffee etc.). Discount is not given on any special promotions which may have already provided discount or on soft drinks dispensed by the vending machine
8. Food discount is given on all menu items and daily special board items. Discount is not given on children's meals, takeaway food, sweets from pro-shop, bar snacks such as crisps, nuts, cookies etc. Food discounts do not apply to special 3 course meals or other special events, unless advertised otherwise. Discount is not given on any special promotions which may have already provided discount
9. Damage to or the loss of a Member Discount card should be reported immediately to the Club Secretary so that the card can be disabled. A replacement card can be obtained from the Club Secretary for a fee of £2
10. Discount cannot be retrospectively applied – the card must be presented at the point of sale in order to obtain discount
11. Member Discount cards do not provide credit facilities to members. They must be presented at the point of sale to obtain discount on a sale that is being paid for by cash or credit card
12. Absolute discretion is granted to the Proprietor to amend the discount rates, amend the products to which discount applies or change / withdraw the discount scheme without ascribing any reason for doing so
